Last year, members helped the Ohio State Building Trades raise over \$50,000 for the Diabetes Research Institute (DRI), whose mission is to find a cure for diabetes. With your help, we hope to exceed that donation this year.



The Ohio State Building and Construction Trades Council is hosting our annual Dollars Against Diabetes (DADs) Day Charity Golf Outing and Banquet on July 12, 2018 at the NorthStar Golf Club in Sunbury. One hundred percent (100%) of the proceeds from this event will be donated directly to the DRI, an organization that was created for one reason – to cure diabetes. Our donation will help DRI reach that goal.

Dollars Against Diabetes is an annual campaign organized by the Building and Construction Trades Department, AFL-CIO. With the help of State and Local Councils around the country, DADs Day events have raised over \$40 million dollars to the Diabetes Research Institute.

We are asking each Local to please forward the enclosed flyer for our DAD's Day Charity Golf Outing and Banquet to your vendors and service providers (pension fund manager, attorneys, etc.) and ask for their support in the Building Trades' goal of raising \$60,000 this year through the event. Registration is \$125 per golfer and \$500 per foursome. Hole sponsorships are available for \$200 and a breakfast sponsorship is \$1000. Donations of giveaways for our golfers are also appreciated. There is no limit to generosity, and larger and/or in-kind donations are gladly accepted.
